

1091 English for Travelling and Guided Tour

What is this club about?

The aim of this club is to cultivate students' capabilities in undertaking a guided tour. Students are expected to learn in a field trip and present their learning outcomes in group works. Local and international students are expected to have language and cultural exchanges by assisting each other surmounting language obstacles. **NO tuition fee is required.**

How to sign up?

Students are required to fill out a signup form on this website: <https://reurl.cc/Grm4Gx> **before October 8th.**

Note:

1. After sign-up, **an E-mail with pre-class notification will be sent to those who are admitted to the course by October 12th.** Once you get the admission mail, please go to the language center to pay the 600NTD deposit **before October 16th** to secure your admission status. Those who do not pay the deposit will lose their eligibility for the course and students on the waiting list will take their places. The waiting list will be released by **October 17th** and students on the list need to pay the deposit **before October 21st.**
2. **Please note that students will visit the wildlife rescue center of the NPUST on October 25th and therefore the deposit deducting the entrance and other fees (NTD100), which is NTD500, will be refunded to students finishing the whole course.**
3. Target group: graduate students, junior and senior undergraduate students who can attend both days of the camp.
4. A certificate of completion will be given to those who attend both days of the course and complete the assignment(s).
5. After sign-up, if you are not able to attend the course, please let us know via email at least one week before the first class starts so that other students on the waiting list can join us.
